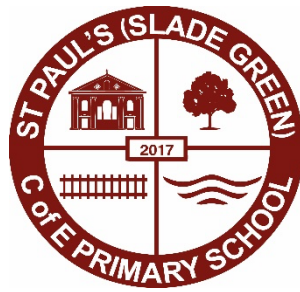

Child P & Child Q who are both currently being supported by a Child Protection Plan (social care).

Child R who is a young carer for a severely disabled sibling.

Child S who is currently being supported by Family Well Being (social care).
